- Demonstrated commitment to and demonstrated ability to network and collaborate with services across the local community mental health network, mainstream health services, and mental health services.
- Good organization, time management and data collection skills
- Demonstrated ability to work effectively as part of a trans-disciplinary team.
- Promote and support reciprocal ways of working i.e., sharing skills and knowledge with an Aboriginal Health Worker in clinical and therapeutic settings.
- Fully approved Covid 19 Vaccinations (including booster)
